To gather information for these evaluations, I studied the top several different brands of ice cream currently being sold in Kroger locations in the city of Denton, Texas. I evaluated the quality of the display of the product, the average cost per oz., as well as other things. I researched customers' reviews of ice cream being sold in the store and took their options into great consideration when testing the feasibility of each of the tested brands. The customer reviews provided great information about taste, consistency and gave me their perspective of what should be done. With Denton being a college town the products have to be reasonable for students to afford.

## Results of the Evaluation

To determine the feasibility of the top brand name ice creams being sold in our Kroger stores in the Denton, Texas area, I evaluated the several criteria of price, size, flavors, and nutritional facts.

## Consumer Reviews

### Blue bell:

Our most popular ice cream and with good reason. It's rich, homemade tasting vanilla ice cream with a special hand-cranked flavor that's the best in the country. Contains only 160 calories per serving or a little over 600 calories for the entire pint. The base is more substantial than low-fat ice cream, but has a fluffier feel than the heavier, high-butterfat options mentioned in the previous paragraph. Despite the lack of super-premium consistency, the effectiveness of the flavors is undeniable.

### Blue bunny:

Blue Bunny had a yummy flavor and specs of vanilla bean in every spoonful. The ingredients list is pretty straight forward with various forms of milk (i.e. cream, skim milk, dry milk) which gives it the smooth and creamy texture.

### Breyers:

Decent prices, rich flavor, excellent nutrition facts,

### Dreyers:

"Delicious, but a bit thick," this "very creamy" ice cream was noted for having a "gourmet-like flavor." Some tasters, however, complained of a "metallic" aftertaste.

### Haagen-Dazs:

Solid vanilla ice cream that actually tastes like vanilla. On top of it all, this Haagen Daz vanilla bean ice cream melts in your mouth the way ice cream should.

### Recommendation

Based on our evaluation of the several criteria we based our information on we have found Blue Bell Ice Cream to be the best overall ice cream to offer to our customers.
